Naloxone: A medication that can quickly reverse the effects of an opiate overdose by blocking receptors in the nervous system. Naloxone is available as a nasal spray (narcan) or as an injection)

Narcan: A brand of naloxone, in the form of a nasal spray.

Naloxone is available to people with Medi-Cal or Medicare with a prescription from their doctor, or can be furnished by participating pharmacies without a prescription.

Most **CVS pharmacies** have naloxone available without a prescription. This is a partial list of CVS locations in LA County where naloxone is available without a prescription. Please call pharmacies to verify availability and cost.
